- Create a Historic Preservation Commission: Establish a commission dedicated to
 overseeing historic preservation efforts, including reviewing proposed alterations or
 demolitions of historic structures and providing guidance on preservation techniques.
- 3. **Incentives for Preservation**: Offer financial incentives such as tax credits, grants, or low-interest loans to property owners who undertake preservation projects or maintain historic buildings.
- 4. **Educational Programs**: Organize educational programs and workshops to raise awareness about the importance of historic preservation and provide property owners with information on preservation techniques and available resources.
- 5. **Partnerships with Preservation Organizations**: Collaborate with local preservation organizations, historical societies, and other stakeholders to leverage their expertise and resources in preservation efforts.
- 6. **Inventory and Documentation**: Conduct surveys to identify historic buildings within the county and maintain a comprehensive inventory of these structures. Encourage property owners to document the history and architectural features of their buildings.

- 8. **Public Awareness Campaigns**: Launch public awareness campaigns to highlight the cultural and economic benefits of historic preservation and garner support for preservation efforts among residents and businesses.

- 9. **Enforcement of Preservation Regulations**: Ensure that historic preservation ordinances are enforced effectively and take appropriate action against violations, such as unauthorized alterations or demolitions of historic structures.
- 10. **Long-Term Planning**: Incorporate historic preservation goals and strategies into the county's comprehensive planning process to ensure that preservation efforts are integrated into broader land use and development policies.

By implementing these strategies, I believe I could play a role in safeguarding the cultural heritage and architectural legacy of historic buildings in Vigo County..
